CITY OF WINNIPEG CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

TO: Residents/Businesses

RE: 2019 Regional Street Renewal Program

Please be advised construction will resume on the Empress Street Overpass over Portage Avenue the week of May 4, 2020. Construction on Empress Street East from Portage Avenue to St. Matthews Avenue will resume the week of May 30, 2020.

Construction Duration:

May 4th to September 30th, 2020

Impacted streets and intersections: Empress Street East from Portage Avenue to St. Matthews Avenue

Portage Avenue Underpass

This construction will continue the work completed in 2019.

Traffic impacts will be as follows:

- From the week of May 11 to September 30:
 - o One lane in each direction on Portage Avenue will be closed. Two lanes will always be open.
- From the week of May 30 to July 15:
 - Southbound Empress Street will be fully closed from St. Matthews Avenue to Jack Blick Avenue.
 - Northbound Empress Street will be reduced to one lane from Jack Blick Avenue to St. Matthews Avenue,
 - Empress Street East between Eastway Avenue and eastbound Portage Avenue will be closed to southbound traffic.
- Pedestrian access, transit service, and access to local businesses will be maintained throughout construction.

We understand that now is a time of much uncertainty but want to assure you we are proceeding on the assumption that construction season will continue this summer.
