



OPPORTUNITIES

- good sightlines from Main Street into park for safety
- accessible via public transit - bus stop near entrance of park
- take advantage of nice views of historical buildings and potential programming with places of worship
- riverbank used by community members for walking trails and mountain biking - future upgrades and connections to existing Active Transportation network
- opportunity for winter activities - topography of gully for tobogganing, open space or river for skating rinks
- open, sunny areas act as gathering space for unprogrammed activities - potential location for Healing Forest
- Picnic in the Park event held every summer for community (August 19, 2017) - opportunity for further community events

CONSTRAINTS

- low volume of vehicle and pedestrian traffic through and around park - signs of drinking and vandalism in the park; unwanted activity along St. Cross Street
- surface drainage an issue during spring thaw - lots of standing water in low spots throughout the park; riverbank and gully floods seasonally
- portion of riverbank is fenced off - dangerous as people use the riverbank as mountain biking and walking trails
- loss of mature trees - further tree planting required to replace aging trees
- high frequency of vandalism and alcohol consumption in park
- spray pads already exist in a 1km radius (Machray & Norquay Parks)
