




Proposal for the purchase of Winnipeg Hydro by Manitoba Hydro







What is being bought?

An electrical utility business



including:

- Generation stations two power dams
- Transmission and distribution systems
- 30% of Winnipeg's electrical customer base



What is the value of Winnipeg Hydro?

Represented by the Balance Sheet of Winnipeg Hydro at December 31, 2001

Assets: \$242 million

Liabilities: \$179 million

Equity: \$63 million (Retained earnings)





What is the value of the purchase offer by Manitoba Hydro? (slide 1 of 2)

Annual Payments to City:

Years 1-5

Years 6-9

Year 10 and beyond

\$25 million per year

\$20 million per year

Annual Savings to City

Guarantee "Power Smart" energy efficiency savings

Downtown Christmas street lighting

\$800,000 per year

\$200,000 per year

\$1 million per year

Employee Job Security

The following guarantees:

- No layoffs
- No reduction in wages



- No reduction in pension plan or other benefits
- Manitoba Hydro would assume all obligations under existing labour contracts





Downtown Development

Manitoba Hydro commits to building a 400,000 square foot office tower in the downtown within the next five years.



Economic impact of new Manitoba Hydro Office Tower

- Estimated \$1 \$1.75 million in new property taxes for the City of Winnipeg.
- Over 2,000 additional employees working in the downtown.
- Positive spin-off to existing businesses in the downtown, and increased motivation for other businesses to relocate there.



Administration's Recommendation

That Council give serious consideration to the purchase offer received from Manitoba Hydro.

Basis:

- Provides annual revenue stream;
- Removes obligation for infrastructure repair;
- Eliminates City's obligation for Winnipeg Hydro debt;
- Development of MB Hydro headquarters downtown;
- Provides property tax revenue from new MB Hydro building;
- Protects employee jobs, wages and benefits.
