

Winnipeg Police Board Hosting Engagement Opportunities for the Winnipeg Police Service 2026 – 2030 Strategic Plan

As the civilian governance body for the Winnipeg Police Service, the Winnipeg Police Board is committed to ensuring that the needs, values, and expectations of the community are reflected in how policing is delivered in the City of Winnipeg. The Board accomplishes this by establishing a strategic plan for the Winnipeg Police Service.

The Board is inviting all those who live, work, or visit the City of Winnipeg to share their visions for policing, the areas where policing is effective or where it could be done differently, and what changes are recommend to bring transformational change to policing and public safety in Winnipeg.

Community consultations sessions, open to the public, will be held:

- June 25, 2025: Bronx Park Community Centre, 720 Henderson Highway, 5:00p.m-7:00p.m.
- July 23, 2025: Fort Rouge Leisure Centre/Osborne Library, 625 Osborne Street, 5:00p.m.-7:00p.m.

Individuals are also able to provide input directly to the Board through an online survey and submission form on the Board's website, <u>www.winnipeg.ca/policeboard</u> until August 31, 2025.

The Board will also be engaging with organizations, community groups, and leaders representing Winnipeg's diverse community to hear their needs, values, and expectations of policing. Focused discussions are being held with leaders from a broad range of sectors, including:

- Newcomer, cultural, and faith organizations
- Indigenous leadership, organizations, businesses, and community members
- Child, family, and youth serving organizations, education, and student representatives
- Community organizations practicing or advocating in social services, health, and community safety and wellbeing
- Businesses, retail, and labour

Input from the community will inform the priorities and objectives for the police service for the next five years.
