

Qualified Opinion

We have audited the accompanying Statement of Income and Expenses and supporting schedules of Rana Bokhari (the "Registered Candidate") for the campaign period ending March 31, 2023, relating to the election held on October 26, 2022.

In our opinion, except for the possible effects of the matter described in the Basis for Qualified Opinion section of our report, the accompanying Statement of Income and Expenses for the campaign period is prepared, in all material respects, in accordance with the financial reporting provisions of By-law No. 10/2010 of *The City of Winnipeg Charter*.

Basis for Qualified Opinion

Due to the nature of the types of transactions inherent in an election campaign, it is impracticable through auditing procedures to determine that the accounting records include all donations of goods and services, receipts, and disbursements for the campaign period. Accordingly, our verification of these transactions was limited to ensuring that the Statement reflects the amounts recorded in the accounting records of the Registered Candidate, in accordance with established accounting procedures and we were not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to income and expenses.

We conducted our audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Statement section of our report. We are independent of the Campaign in accordance with the ethical requirements that are relevant to our audit of the Statement in Canada, and we have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion.

Emphasis of Matter - Basis of Accounting and Restriction on Use

Without modifying our opinion, we draw attention to Note 1 to the Statement, which describes the basis of accounting. The Statement is prepared to comply with the financial reporting provisions of By-law No. 10/2010 of *The City of Winnipeg Charter*. The statement is filed with the Campaign Expenses and Contributions Officer for the City of Winnipeg. As a result, the Statement may not be suitable for another purpose. Our report is intended solely for the Registered Candidate and Official Agent and the Campaign Expenses and Contributions Officer for the City of Winnipeg and should not be used by parties other than the Registered Candidate and Official Agent and the Campaign Expenses and Contributions Officer for the City of Winnipeg.

Responsibilities of Registered Candidate and Official Agent for the Statement

The Registered Candidate and the Official Agent are responsible for the preparation of the Statement in accordance with the financial reporting provisions of By-law No. 10/2010 of *The City of Winnipeg Charter*, and for such internal control as management determines is necessary to enable the preparation of the Statement that is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

In preparing the Statement, the Registered Candidate and the Official Agent are responsible for assessing the campaign's ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters relating to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless the Registered Candidate and the Official Agent either intend to liquidate the campaign or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so.

The Registered Candidate and the Official Agent are responsible for overseeing the campaign's financial reporting process.

Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Statement

Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the Statement as a whole is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes our opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance, but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of this Statement. As part of an audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards, we exercise professional judgment and maintain professional skepticism throughout the audit. We also:

- Identify and assess the risks of material misstatement of the financial statement, whether due to fraud or error, design and perform audit procedures responsive to those risks, and obtain audit evidence that is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion. The risk of not detecting a material misstatement resulting from fraud is higher than for one resulting from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentations, or the override of internal control.
- Obtain an understanding of internal control relevant to the audit in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the entity's internal control.
