An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the statement. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the statement, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the entity's preparation of the statement in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the entity's internal control. Accordingly, our verification of these transactions was limited to ensuring that the financial statement reflects the amounts recorded in the accounting records of the Registered Candidate, in accordance with established accounting procedures and we were not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to income and expenses.

#### **Qualified Opinion**

In our opinion, except for the effect of the matter described in the Basis for Qualified Opinion paragraph, the Statement of Income and Expenses and supporting schedules of Andrew Podolecki for the campaign period ending March 31, 2015 relating to the election held on October 22, 2014 are prepared, in all material respects, in accordance with the financial reporting provisions of By-law No. 10/2010

### Basis of Accounting and Restriction on Use
