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Independent Auditors' Report On Form 4, Audited Financial Statement Pursuant to the City of Winnipeg Charter

To the Campaign Expense and Contributions Officer for the City of Winnipeg

We have audited the accompanying Form 4, Audited Financial Statement, prepared in accordance with the accounting requirements of By-law No. 10/2010 of *The City of Winnipeg Charter*, for the candidacy of Keith Bellamy, a candidate at the election for a city councillor in the Daniel McIntyre Ward held on October 22, 2014.

Official Agent's Responsibility for the Financial Information

The Official Agent is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the financial statement in accordance with accounting requirements of By-law No. 10/2010 of *The City of Winnipeg Charter*, and for such internal control as management determines is necessary to enable the preparation of financial information that is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditors' Responsibility

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on this financial statement based on our audit. We conducted our audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Those standards require that we comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial information is free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial information. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial information, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the entity's preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the entity's internal control. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial statement.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our qualified audit opinion.

Independent Auditors' Report On Form 4, Audited Financial Statement Pursuant to the City of Winnipeg Charter

Basis for Qualified Opinion

Due to the nature of the types of transactions inherent in an election campaign, it is impracticable through auditing procedures to determine that the accounting records include all donations of goods and services, receipts and disbursements for the campaign period. Accordingly, our verification of these transactions was limited to ensuring that the financial statements reflect the amounts recorded in the accounting records of the candidate, in accordance with established accounting procedures and we were not able to determine whether any adjustment might be necessary to receipts and disbursements.

Qualified Opinion

In our opinion, except for the effects of adjustments, if any, which we might have determined to be necessary had we been able to satisfy ourselves concerning the completeness of the records as described in the preceding paragraph, these statements present fairly the information contained in the accounting records on which the statements are based in accordance with prescribed accounting treatment.

Basis of Accounting and Restriction on Distribution and Use

Form 4, Audited Financial Statement, has been prepared in accordance with the accounting requirements of By-law No. 10/2010 of *The City of Winnipeg Charter*. The statements are not intended to be and should not be used by anyone other than the specified users or for any other purposes.
