

Designated Growers Licence Checklist

This checklist is designed to serve as a guide for those interested in obtaining a Designated Growers Licence. It is your responsibility to make sure you are aware of and comply with the terms of your application. The following is not a complete list, but will give you an idea of your responsibilities.

Please note: Requirement #6 is only required for facilities that are planning to grow six or more cannabis plants.

	REQUIREMENTS	DETAILS/RESOURCES	
1.	Business Location	Find a business location that meets zoning requirements (the location must be in an industrial zone). To make sure you can conduct this type of business on the premises, contact: Zoning & Permits Unit 31 – 30 Fort Street 204-986-5140	
2.	Alarm Permit	Your premises will require a monitored alarm system under the Alarm By-law No. 4676/87. To apply for an alarm permit, visit your nearest police station or go <u>online</u> .	
3.	Municipal Permits	 A copy of all permits that are required for work to make the premises appropriate for cannabis production, including: Electrical permits Building permits Permits authorizing the installation of heating, ventilation and air conditioning systems Other permits that the designated employee may request 	
4.	Provincial/Federal Permits	A copy of all permits or authorizations by provincial or federal authorities. • Registration certifications issued by Health Canada	
5.	Authorization document to use the premises	If you are the registered owner of the premises, provide us with a copy of the land title; or If you are not the registered owner of the premises, provide a letter of authorization signed by all registered owners to use the premises as a designated cannabis production facility.	



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
