

Wading Pool and Spray Pad Rules

Wading pools have a maximum depth of 45–60 cm (18–24 in.)

- For children 12 years of age and under.
- Children under 7 years of age must have a parent/guardian 12 years of age or older **actively** supervising them.
- Appropriate swimwear is required (i.e. swimsuit, shorts).
- Wading Pool Attendant must be on duty while swimming (wading pools only).
- Children who are not toilet trained are required to wear a leak-proof swim garment.
- No horse play. This includes, but is not limited to: running, climbing structures, spitting water.
- No smoking within 30 m (City of Winnipeg BY-LAW NO. 62/2011).
- No alcohol/drugs.
- No glass or food on the pool deck.
- No large inflatable toys, water guns or sand.
- No bicycles/skateboards/scooters/in-line skates, etc.
- No abusive/profane language.
- Animals are not permitted, with the exception of service animals.
- Do not drink pool water or water from spray features.
- Water shoes are recommended.
- Persons infected with a communicable disease or having open sores cannot enter the water.

Slide Rules

- Children 12 years of age and under only.
- Children under 7 years of age must be actively supervised when using the slide.
- Feet first only.
- One child permitted at a time.
- No playing at the bottom of the slide.

Spray Pads Are Unsupervised

- We recommend that children under 12 years of age be accompanied by a parent/guardian.
- Adults must be accompanied by children at the following combined spray pads/wading pools:
 - Central Park
 - Machary Park
 - Sturgeon Heights
 - Vimy Ridge Memorial Park
 - Westdale
 - West Kildonan
 - Shaughnessy Park



Use of Technological Devices at all Aquatic Facilities

We understand the importance for families and friends to capture precious moments in a picture.

For a positive and safe experience for all the patrons at any of our aquatic facilities, patrons wishing to use cameras, video cameras or other photographic/smart devices to take pictures at the pool must have permission from staff before filming or snapping that forever pose.

All technological devices are prohibited in the washrooms, change rooms and locker rooms.

Active Supervision

Role of Parent/Guardian

- Children under 7 years of age must be accompanied in the water by a parent/guardian at a ratio of 1:4 (1 guardian to 4 children).
- Stay within arm's reach of your child(ren) at all times.
- When parents entrust the supervisory responsibilities to a guardian they should ensure that the guardian understands and accepts the responsibility they are given. Guardians are required to be 12 years of age or older.
- Parents/Guardians are responsible for the behaviour of the child(ren) they bring to the wading pool.



Role of a Wading Pool Attendant

- To provide a safe and enjoyable experience through the performance of a high standard of care for the safety of our patrons.
- The Wading Pool Attendant's primary function is accident prevention achieved through patron education and influencing or directing patron behaviours.
- Wading Pool Attendants work with patrons to ensure an understanding of pool rules, identification of potential risks and how to be water smart at a wading pool.
- Wading Pool Attendants have complete authority with the emphasis on safety first. Should there be any safety issues regarding patrons use of the facility, wading pool attendants have the right to allow or prevent access to any part of the wading pool or the wading pool in its entirety.

Please note: Washroom facilities are not always available on site at spray pads.



Help Prevent Pool Closures

- ✓ Please avoid eating 1 hour prior to swimming to avoid upset stomach
- ✓ Please ensure that children are taken to the washroom prior to swimming and frequently take breaks during swimming
- ✓ Non-toilet trained infants / toddlers & participants who experience incontinence must wear the appropriate leak-proof garments
- ✓ Participants should not swim if they feel ill, have an upset stomach, diarrhea or have vomited in the past day
- ✓ Be sure to change diapers in the change rooms (not pool side) and dispose of them properly
- ✓ Wash your hands after using the toilet or changing diapers

Pool closures are a result of the contamination of pool water by fecal matter and vomit or reduced water clarity.

Water quality is managed according to the Manitoba Health Act regulations.

Pool Closures at Outdoor Aquatic Facilities

Check winnipeg.ca or contact 311 for current information.

An outdoor pool or wading pool may be closed throughout the day if any of the following conditions arise:

- The weather turns to thundershowers during the day.
- Lightning and/or thunder are present.
- Water, electricity, access to a phone for emergencies, first aid kit or washroom facilities are not available.
- Foreign material, such as glass, fecal matter, vomit, animals or blood, is found in the water and has the potential to affect pool water.
- Maintenance issues.
- Pool water clarity or quality does not meet Manitoba Public Health Act standards.

Closing Procedures for Wading Pools

Draining of the wading pool is coordinated with the time the pool closes. Staff begin draining the pool prior to closing and as a result, there will not be a full basin of water at closing time. Children will be permitted to stay in the wading pool while it is draining under the following conditions:

- Children do not play near or sit on the drain.
- There is no whirlpool present.
- The Wading Pool Attendant does not have to leave the wading pool area to attend to other facility requirements.

Groups Using Wading Pools

Groups are welcome during regular scheduled hours. Wading pools are free public facilities, bookings for group events such as birthday parties cannot be made. Capacity restrictions, group ratios and supervision requirements must be met for all group use.

When using City of Winnipeg facilities:

- Groups are required to adhere to all rules.
- The Wading Pool Attendant has the right to allow or prevent access to any part of the wading pool or the pool in its entirety should there be any safety concerns regarding the group's use of the facility.
- If the wading pool is at capacity, groups will be required to wait until space becomes available.

Group Leader/Child Ratios at Wading Pools

For the safety of all children who attend the wading pool with a group, group leader to child ratios are required to be in place prior to entry into the pool. These ratios take into account each child's different skills and abilities in an aquatic environment.

- **Children under 7 years of age:** one leader required for every four children (1:4 ratio).
- **Children 7-12 years of age:** one leader required for every fifteen children (1:15 ratio).
- Maximum group size is 30.
- Groups will be limited to a maximum of 2 hours during high demand.

Role of the Group Leader

- Group leader to child ratios must be adhered to when the children are in the water and surrounding area.
- Group leaders must be within arm's reach of children when in the water for children under 7 years of age.
- Group leaders must be actively supervising their group both in the water and surrounding area such as the spray pad.
- Group leaders are responsible for the behaviour of the children that they bring to the wading pool.
