Add B9.2 (g) Separate Price – Item No. 7 shall be the amount to be deducted from the lump sum price if separate price item # 7 is deleted in accordance with Section 00301 of the Specifications.

#### Revise B15.4(c) to read:

(a) if the lowest evaluated responsive Total Bid submitted by a responsible and qualified Bidder exceeds the budgetary provision for the Work, the lump sum prices of all responsive Bids submitted by responsible and qualified Bidders will be adjusted by progressively deducting separate prices in the order listed in B9.2 until a Total Bid Price within the budgetary provision is achieved, i.e., Total Bid Price = Lump Sum Price -Separate Price No. 1 - Separate Price No. 2 - Separate Price No. 3 - Separate Price No. 4 - Separate Price No. 5 - Separate Price No. 6 - Separate Price No. 7. Add 2.1.1.2 Acceptable material approved as equal IKO Aquabarrier AVB

Add 2.1.2.2 Acceptable material approved as equal IKO Aquabarrier AVB

Add 2.1.3.2 Acceptable material approved as equal IKO Aquabarrier TG

Add 2.1.4.2 Acceptable material approved as equal IKO Aquabarrier AVB

Add 2.1.9.2 Acceptable material approved as equal IKO Armourgard Vapour Retardant

Section 07311 Asphalt Shingles; Add 3.1.3 All asphalt shingles to be hand tabbed with adhesive as specified.

Delete Section 08330 Rolling Shutters. Refer to Section 10999 Miscellaneous Specialties Clause 2.4 for information regarding Rolling Shutters.

Section 09651 Resilient Flooring; Revise clause 2.1.8 to read:

Multi-Function Flooring / Washrooms: Mondo Ramflex or Sport Impact, square tiles, 3/8" thick, colour(s) as chosen by Contract Administrator from full colour range.

Approved Alternate: Johnsonite "Replay – Fusion" 3/8" thick, 24" x 24", square tiles, allow for 10% decorator solids, colour as chosen by Contract Administrator from full colour range.

Approved Alternate: Dinoflex "Sportmat" 3/8" thick, square tile, 30% colour flex (Colour as selected by Contract Administrator from standard colour range), allow for 10% "Stone line" tiles.

Section 10999 Miscellaneous Specialties;

Add sentence 2.1.3 All semi-recessed cabinets for fire extinguishers must have breakable glass to access door handles.

Delete Clause 2.6.1

Add sentence 2.8.4 "No Parking Signage

Add 2.8.4.1 Material: black and white colour aluminum signs (2), 12" x 18" c/w "No Parking – Fire Lane" mounted on galvanized steel post embedded in ground 900mm, sign mounted 1220mm above grade.

Add 2.8.4.2 Location: At 2 locations along entrance curb as directed by Contract Administrator.

Section 15051 Acceptable Materials and Equipment:

Add 1.2.5.3 Fire damper approved manufacturer NCA/EH Price

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Add 1.2.6.1 Temperature control system approved manufacturers BSD Solutions (Alerton) and Integrated Control Systems

#### Section 15180 Insulation:

Replace clause 2.6 Vapour Barrier Rigid Insulation with clause

- 2.6 Vapour Barrier Flexible Duct Insulation.
  - .1 Following duct externally insulated with Fibreglas RFFRK reinforced foil-faced vapour seal duct insulation PF335, 340 g. (3/4 lb./cu.ft.) density.
    - .1 25mm (1") Thickness
      - .1 All round supply air ductwork, and all rectangular supply air ductwork, less than 1200mm (48") wide on discharge of fan systems with cooling coils.
      - .2 All supply air ductwork on discharge of fan.
    - .2 50mm (2") Thickness
      - .1 All exhaust and relief ducts, supply and return air ducts from/to RTUs not shown acoustically lined from roof or wall back for a length of 1.8m (6'-0") or from wall or roof discharge back to damper.
      - .2 All roof ducting to centrifugal exhaust fans located on roofs.
      - .3 All outside air ductwork.
      - .4 When duct pass through cold attic spaces, vapour barrier on insulation should be eliminated.

Add clause 2.12.2.9 Eyewash # 1

- .1 Bradley S19-220, plastic bowl c/w wall mounting bracket, tailpiece, chrome plated brass soft flow spray heads, ½" IPS chrome plated stay-open ball valve, ANSI compliance Z358.1-1998.
- .2 Mixing valve MXI: Leonard TA-300, standard emergency mixing valve with integral cold water by-pass, 4 GPM, check stops on inlets, wall mounting bracket, outlet thermometer and rough bronze finish.

### Division 15 Mechanical Schedules;

Add Note to detail sheet MS-1A and MS-1B all thermostats for air handling units to include night set back settings.

Revise fan EF-4 on detail sheet MS-2 to Greenheck belt drive side wall type, c/w back draft damper, damper guard, birdscreen and weather hood. Model SBE-1H20-4, 300 CFM at .5" S.P., ¼ H.P. Mount fan u/s of ceiling. Locate CO sensor as per note 32 on drawing M2-1. Locate fan on exterior wall around grid line 'c'.

Add Detail Sheet MD-5 Eye/Face Wash Station c/w Mixing Valve.

#### Division 16 Electrical Schedules:

Revise electrical panel schedule B from 60 circuit panel to 84 circuit double tub panel.
