Revise:	E4.4.1	Permission has been obtained from the owner at 275 Scotia Street to access the Site using the
		driveway and yard at this residence. The Contractor is advised that the deck shown on the
		drawings may be under construction during the duration of the Contract. The home owner has
		agreed to keep the driveway free of obstructions during construction of the dike.

- E4.4.2 The Contractor is advised that equipment used to access the Site shall be of a size and weight that damage to the Site access area is minimized, in particular the driveway and retaining wall at 275 Scotia Street. The Contractor shall repair, at his cost, any damage to the retaining walls or other property as a result of the Work, to conditions equal or better than existing.
- E4.4.3 No other access points to the Work area shall be permitted, without prior approval from the affected property owner. The Contractor shall restore, at his cost, any damage caused by the access points to conditions equal or better than existing and to the satisfaction of the homeowner.
- E4.4.4 The Contractor shall take necessary precautions to prevent access by equipment and delivery vehicles from using the paved driveways at 265 and 271 Scotia Street, unless arrangements as set out in E4.4.3 have been made. The Contractor shall repair, at his expense, any damage to these driveways as a result of the Work.
- E4.5.5 The entire parking pad at 265 Scotia Street and driveway at 275 Scotia shall be restored to existing conditions and surfaced with compacted Base Course Material as shown on the drawings.
- E6.3.1(a) Unless otherwise indicated on the drawings, the piles of rubble and the retaining walls in the back yard at 275 Scotia Street shall be removed and disposed of by the Contractor.
