Please note the following and attached changes, corrections, additions, deletions, information and/or instructions in connection with the Request for Proposal, and be governed accordingly. Failure to acknowledge receipt of this Addendum in Paragraph 10 of Form A: Proposal may render your Proposal non-responsive.

PART D – SUPPLEMENTAL CONDITIONS

Revise D10.1 to read: The Contractor shall provide and maintain the following insurance coverage:

(a) commercial general liability insurance, in the amount of at least five million dollars (\$5,000,000.00) all inclusive, with The City of Winnipeg added as an additional insured, with a cross-liability clause, and such liability policy to also contain a contractual liability endorsement to remain in place at all times during the performance of the Work and throughout the warranty period;

(b) automobile liability insurance for owned automobiles used for or in connection with the Work in the amount of at least five million dollars (\$5,000,000.00) at all times during the performance of the Work;

(c) automobile liability insurance for non-owned automobiles used for or in connection with the Work in the amount of at least five million dollars (\$5,000,000.00) at all times during the performance of the Work. Non-owned automobile liability may be endorsed onto either of the above noted policies detailed in D10.1 (a) or D 10.1 (b). The Certificate of Insurance to expressly state "operations of the insured to cover Handi-Transit transport of passengers."

Revise D10.5 to read: The City shall have the right to alter the limits and/or coverages as reasonably required from time to time during the continuance of this agreement.

PART E - SPECIFICATIONS

Revise E4.5 to read: Vehicles used for hourly Work under this Contract will be no more than five (5) years of age from the first registration date at any time during the Contract without the prior written approval of the Contract Administrator.
