### PART D – SUPPLEMENTAL CONDITIONS

Revise: D9 to read:

#### D9. Insurance

- D9.1 The Contractor shall provide and maintain the following insurance coverage:
  - (a) Commercial general liability insurance, in the amount of at least two million dollars (\$2,000,000.00) inclusive, with The City of Winnipeg added as an additional insured and a cross-liability clause; such liability policy to also contain contractual liability, non-owned automobile liability, unlicensed motor vehicle liability and products and completed operations to remain in place at all times during the performance of the Work and throughout the warranty period;
  - (b) Automobile liability insurance for owned automobiles used for or in connection with the Work in the amount of at least two million dollars (\$2,000,000.00) to remain in place at all times during the performance of the Work;
  - (c) The certificate of insurance must expressly state "Operations to include Railway Crossing Maintenance" and shall expressly verify that "This policy does not include a Failure to Perform Exclusion."
- D9.2 Deductibles shall be borne by the Contractor.
- D9.3 The Contractor shall provide the Contract Administrator with a certificate of insurance for each policy at least two (2) Business Days prior to the commencement of any Work but in no event later than seven (7) Calendar Days from notification of the award of Contract. The certificate/certificates must detail all insurance requirements outlined under section D9.1.
- D9.4 The Contractor shall not cancel, materially alter, or cause the policy to lapse without providing at least fifteen (15) Calendar Days prior written notice to the Contract Administrator.
