Revise: E6.1 to read: All temporary regulatory signs shall be in accordance with the Manual of Temporary

Traffic Control. The Contractor shall bear all costs associated with the placement of temporary traffic control devices required in connection with the works undertaken by the

Contractor.

Revise: E10.2.1(v) to read: gradation requirements, as follows:

Canadian Metric	Percent of Total Dry Weight
Sieve Size	Passing Each Sieve
150 000	100
50 000	75 - 90
25 000	20 - 50
80	0 - 8

Revise: E10.2.2(a) to read: Clay fill for the 1.2 m thick plug at the top of the rock columns shall be clay excavated

from the drilling of the rock column shafts.

Revise: E10.3.7(a) to read: The rock columns shall be sealed with a minimum of **1.2 m** of compacted clay.

Revise: E10.3.7(b) to read: Where this thickness of clay will not be achieved during riverbank regrading a plug of

compacted clay shall be placed at the top of the rock columns such that there will be a minimum of **1.2 m** of compacted clay above the top of the crushed limestone after

regrading.
