PART E - SPECIFICATIONS

Revise: E2.4 to read: Excavation shall be performed in a manner that minimizes damage to the existing root

systems. Where possible, excavation shall be carried out such that the edge of the excavation shall be a minimum of 3m from the closest edge of the trunk. Where roots must be cut to facilitate excavation, they shall be pruned neatly at the face of excavation by an arborist certified to practice in the Province of Manitoba. They must be properly trimmed with sharp tools to prevent crushing or being pulled up by construction

equipment. No paint is required. All exposed roots must be mulched until the excavated

area is filled with clean earth to avoid exposure to sunlight and desiccation.

Revise: E20.47 to read: Concrete wall core shall be measured on a square face meter basis. The face area to be

paid for shall be the total number of square face metres of wall placed in accordance with

this Specification and the Construction Drawings, as determined by the Contract

Administrator.

Revise: E20.50 to read: Concrete wall core will be paid for at the contract square face meter price for "Supply and

install Concrete core", as specified herein, which price shall be payment in full for performing all operations herein described and all other items incidental to the Work

included in this specification.

Add: E20.51 Walls below grade (grade varies on face and back of wall, refer to Grading Plan L2) to

be damproofed with the following:

(a) For installation at ambient temperature above 5 degees C, use bakor 700-01 diluted 20 percent by volume with water as surface primer, and bakor 700-01 as asphalt emulsion.

(b) For installation at ambient temperature below 5 degees C, use bakor 910-01 as surface primer and bakor 710-11 as asphalt emulsion.

(c) Provide 2 layers reinforcing fabric using bakor yellow jacket 990-06.

(d) Provide one layer of exterior protection board over membrane using 990-31.

(e) Follow all manufacturers instructions during application process.
