Add:

Revise:	E2.1 to read:	If hazardous materials, with the exception of Asbestos Containing Materials (ACM's), are encountered during the Work of the Contract, the Contractor shall stop all work and notify the Contract Administrator immediately. Removal of the hazardous materials shall be dealt with by the City and the Contractor shall await further instruction by the Contract Administrator
Add:	E2.2	The Contractor shall be responsible for the removal and disposal of any ACM's directly impeding the work to complete the re-roofing at the buildings herein described in this specification.
Add:	E2.2.1	Removal and handling of ACM's is to be performed by persons trained in the methods, procedures and practices for asbestos abatement.

Removal and disposal of any ACM's shall be in compliance with the latest Federal,

Provincial and local requirements for such work.
