 - (vii) 1 virtual AS/400 Operating System Images;
 - (viii) 3 physical AS/400 Operating System Images;
 - (ix) 26 VMware ESX Hosts;
 - (x) 22 Oracle Database Servers;
 - (xi) 16 SQL Server Servers;
 - (xii) 1 DB2 Servers;
 - (xiii) 35 application servers (combination of WebLogic, Oracle Application Server, TomCat, JBOSS, ...);
 - (xiv) 42 Web Servers (IIS, Apache);
 - (xv) 11 Exchange/SMTP/BES Servers;
 - (xvi) 10 network locations requiring remote client monitoring;
