## PART E – SPECIFICATIONS

- Revise: E1.2.4 to read:
- E1.2.4 The following are applicable to the Work:
- E1.2.5 Specification to rebuild a pair of Montgomery pedestrian escalators located at the Scotia Bank entrance of the Portage and Main Concourse, 365 Main Street.
- E1.2.6 Supply all labour, materials, applicable permits and Manitoba Dept. of Labour inspections to remove and replace existing escalator components listed herein.
- E1.2.7 Rebuild to be CSA 2007 and B44 Code compliant.
- E1.2.8 All replacement components to be compatible to Original Equipment Manufacturers Specifications.
  - Remove and replace with all new escalator step boxes, complete with new spindles and rollers.
  - Install new aluminum walk on plates complete with comb impact switches.
  - Install "Zero speed" handrail **sensors**.
  - Supply and install 4 new handrails and handrail guides (incline, curve and roller sections).
  - Overhaul existing gearbox complete with new seals and bearings.
  - Remove existing electric drive motors, clean & service as required, reinstall same.
  - Install "Ecostart Controller" upgrade system.
  - Resurface skirt sides with an application of black silicone resurfacer.
  - Service and replace as necessary all skirt impact switches, adjust skirt/step clearance to meet B44 Code.
  - Clean up debris and oil residue at the underside of both escalators.
- E1.2.9 Work may proceed during normal business hours.
- E1.2.10 Suitable barriers to be placed to protect all persons.
