## PART D - SUPPLEMENTAL CONDITIONS

Revise: D11.4(a) to read:

D11.4(a)

commercial general liability insurance, in the amount of at least **ten** million dollars (\$10,000,000.00) inclusive, with The City of Winnipeg added as an additional insured; such liability policy to also contain a cross-liability clause, non-owned automobile liability and products and completed operations cover, to remain in place at all times during the performance of the Work;

## **Questions and Answers**

- Q1 Can the Commissioning agent have their commissioning specs included in the contractors bid specification? If not, what does the specification to Mechanical, Electrical and Controls spec say on Commissioning?
  - A1 The commissioning specs cannot be included in the General Contractor's bid specification. This project is a GMP project which has already been tendered.

Presently, the M&E and Controls specifications are being re-visited, however they should include the general boiler plate commissioning comments in regards to assisting the commissioning agent during the commissioning phase.

- Q2 D2.2 (d) indicates Telecommunications Equipment. Does this include IT equipment and supporting infrastructure (wiring etc)?
  - Yes "IT equipment" and supporting infrastructure is included within the heading "Telecommunications Equipment". The commissioning services requested in the RFP are to include full services for commissioning of all systems as described in the RFP including section D2.2
- **Q3** E2.2(c) calls for a design review "to ensure achievement of Program of Requirements". Can the Program of Requirements be provided and reviewed before the bid?
  - A3 No, the Program of Requirements will be provided only to the successful bidder once level 2 security clearance is achieved. The program of Requirements cannot be reviewed before the submission of the bids.
