Revise: B2.1 to read:

B2.1 The Submission Deadline is 4:00 p.m. Winnipeg time, March 12, 2012

PART D - SUPPLEMENTAL CONDITIONS

Revise: D11.1 to read:

- D11.1 The Contractor shall provide and maintain performance security until the expiration of the **initial** warranty period in the form of:
 - a performance bond of a company registered to conduct the business of a surety in Manitoba, in the form attached to these Supplemental Conditions (Form H1: Performance Bond), in the amount of fifty percent (50%) of the Contract Price; or
 - (b) an irrevocable standby letter of credit issued by a bank or other financial institution registered to conduct business in Manitoba and drawn on a branch located in Winnipeg, in the form attached to these Supplemental Conditions (Form H2: Irrevocable Standby Letter of Credit), in the amount of fifty percent (50%) of the Contract Price; or
 - (c) a certified cheque or draft payable to "The City of Winnipeg", drawn on a bank or other financial institution registered to conduct business in Manitoba, in the amount of fifty percent (50%) of the Contract Price.
- D11.1.1 Where the performance security is in the form of a certified cheque or draft, it will be deposited by the City. The City will not pay any interest on certified cheques or drafts furnished as performance security.

Revise: D19.1 to read:

- D19.1 Notwithstanding C12, the warranty period shall begin on the date of **commencement of operation of the** rainfall monitoring stations and shall expire one year thereafter unless extended pursuant to C12.3, in which case it shall expire when provided for thereunder.
- D19.1.1 Further to D19.1, should the City and the Contractor mutually agree to extend the Contract the warranty period(s) will be extended for the terms of the each mutually agreed upon extension.
