### **PART B - BIDDING PROCEDURES**

Add B8.1.1: Inspection allowance indicated in Item No. 4d of Form B (R1) is the total number of hours

required for only the Contract Administration phase of the Scope of Services with the

breakdown as follows:

(a) Mezzanine 100hours

(b) Installation, termination and calibration of all instrumentation 100 hours

(c) WTRPO control system communications network 60 hours

Add B8.1.2: Inspection allowance shall be at the discretion of the Project Director.

Add B8.2.1: The Proponent shall provide detailed description of fees for items in B8.1.1 (a), (b) and

(c). The details shall include

(a) key personnel carrying out the inspection;

(b) hourly rates; and

(c) subtotal of fees for each inspection item listed in B8.1.1.

Add B11.1.1: For ongoing projects, the design phase of the project should have been completed or

neari ng completion.

Revise: B20.8 (c) to read: appropriateness of hours assigned to individual tasks, per person, and in relation to

hourly rates.

## PART D - SUPPLEMENTAL CONDITIONS

Revise D7.4.2(b) to read:

The plan shall include but not be limited to:

- (i) The schedule submitted under B13. Proponent should note that:
  - Progress meetings shall be scheduled when pre-defined milestone are achieved and upon completion of major deliverables defined in D8 to D13;
  - The successful Consultant may be required to make changes to their schedule.
  - The reviewed and approved schedule shall not change during the course of the project.
  - If the Consultant is behind schedule, they shall find ways of making up for lost time without affecting the schedule.
  - The successful consultant shall allow for one workshop during the Preliminary Design Phase and if required, one workshop during the Detailed Design Phase.

Revise: D10.2 to read:

The consultant shall allow for 260 hours of inspection for this phase of work as detailed in B8.1.1.
