## PART B – BIDDING PROCEDURES

Revise: B2.1 to read: The Submission Deadline is now 12:00 noon Winnipeg time, October 30, 2012.

## PART E - SPECIFICATIONS

Revise: D17.1 to read: If the Contractor fails to achieve Substantial Performance in accordance with the Contract

by the day fixed herein for Substantial Performance, the Contractor shall pay the City one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) per Calendar Day for each and every Calendar Day following the day fixed herein for Substantial Performance during which such failure

continues.

Revise: E12.3(b)(vii) to read: Install groundwater depressurization well and all pumping required to locally draw down

the groundwater elevation to the underside elevation of the proposed construction

excavation.

Revise: E12.3(b)(viii) to read: Any groundwater that may be encountered during excavation and is pumped out must

not be pumped down the river bank directly over the ground surface. The groundwater only shall be pumped and carried via a hose from the excavation and discharged directly

into the river.

Add: E12.3(b)(ix): The Contractor shall meet all Provincial regulations when installing depressurization wells

and pumping groundwater from the excavation.

Add: E12.3(b)(x): The Contractor shall be responsible for testing the groundwater from the excavation to

applicable guidelines prior to discharge into the river. If the groundwater test results are deemed to be unsuitable for discharge into the river, the Contractor shall be responsible

for removing the groundwater from the site by tanker truck and disposing the

groundwater at a water treatment plant.
