Questions and Answers

- Q1 Can we get the model number of the Parker spreader units that the City has installed? For example does the city use: Parker Chelsea SEMST
 - A1 Parker spreader units' model number is Parker IQAN. Communication with these controllers is via J1939 CAN BUS protocol.
- Q2 Can we get an example of the equipment in a vehicle that has an existing modem?
 - A2 The intent of this requirement is to make it possible in the future. That was also the reason behind not providing any required specification, rather asking the Bidders to specify what interface their equipment would support if it would allow this flexibility of connection pooling.

Here is a possible usage scenario: a router may be used to share the internet connection already in place in a vehicle (a cellular data connection). In this case, the AVL system should have the option of hooking up to the router using an Ethernet cable to route AVL data traffic through this router.

- Q3 Is it possible to get a list of vendors/suppliers that have requested the RFP?
 - A3 The City has no way of determining who downloads the RFP document from the website; therefore, we do not have a list of Bidders.
- Q4 Is it possible to get the RFP document in Word format?
 - A4 The City has provided Part E Specifications, in Word format, for the convenience of Bidders.
