Please note the following and attached changes, corrections, additions, deletions, information and/or instructions in connection with the Bid Opportunity, and be governed accordingly. Failure to acknowledge receipt of this Addendum in Paragraph 8 of Form A: Bid may render your Bid non-responsive.

### PART E - SPECIFICATIONS

Add: E6.3 Further to Clause E6.1, the Contractor can choose to either:

- (a) Bell the line post piles and the end/corner post piles, and use the pile diameter and lengths as indicated on Drawing D-2123; or
- (b) If the Contractor does not want to bell the line post piles and the end/corner post piles, the Contractor can use straight piles with the following dimensions:
  - (i) Line post piles shall be constructed with a 300 mm concrete diameter pile and shall be 1.8 m deep.
  - (ii) End/corner post piles shall be constructed with a 450 mm concrete diameter pile and shall be 1.8 m deep.

Revise: E7.1 (a) to read: Supply and install gates with the same fencing features as specified in E5.4 and as

shown on drawing D-2123.

Revise: E7.2 (a) to read: Supply and install gates with the same fencing features as specified in E5.4 and as

shown on drawing D-2123.

Revise: E8.4 to read: All work shall be carried out without interfering with the railway operations. The railway

dispatcher shall be contacted daily (Monday to Friday) at 1530 hours (telephone number 204-986-4175) to advise of daily work activities and receive notification of proposed train movements in either direction. The Water Treatment Plant Control Centre shall be contacted on Saturdays and Sundays at 0800 hours (telephone number 204-986-5000) to advise of daily work activities and receive notification of proposed train movements in

either direction.

#### PART F - SECURITY CLEARANCE

#### Add: F.1 SECURITY CLEARANCE

- B1.1 Each individual proposed to perform Work under the Contract shall be required to obtain a Criminal Record Search Certificate from the police service having jurisdiction at his place of residence. This can be obtained from one of the following;
  - (a) police service having jurisdiction at his/her place of residence; or

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- (b) BackCheck, forms to be completed can be found on the website at: <a href="http://www.backcheck.net/">http://www.backcheck.net/</a>; or
- (c) Commissionaires (Manitoba Division), forms to be completed can be found on the website at: http://www.commissionaires.mb.ca/.
- B1.2 The original Criminal Record Search Certificate (Form P–253) will be provided by the Winnipeg Police Service to the individual applicant. The original has a validation sticker from the Winnipeg Police Service in the top right hand corner. The applicant shall:
  - (a) Provide the original Criminal Record Search Certificate (Form P-253) to the Contract Administrator.
- B1.3 Prior to the commencement of any Work, and during the term of the Contract if additional or replacement individuals are proposed to perform Work, the Contractor shall supply the Contract Administrator with a Criminal Record Search Certificate obtained not earlier than one (1) year prior to the Submission Deadline, or a certified true copy thereof, for each individual proposed to perform the Work.
- B1.4 Any individual for whom a Criminal Record Search Certificate is not provided, or for whom a Criminal Record Search Certificate indicates any convictions or pending charges related to property offences or crimes against another person will not be permitted to perform any Work.
- B1.5 Any Criminal Record Search Certificate obtained thereby will be deemed valid for the duration of the Contract subject to a repeated records search as hereinafter specified.
- B1.6 Notwithstanding the foregoing, at any time during the term of the Contract, the City may, at its sole discretion and acting reasonably, require an updated criminal records search. Any individual who fails to provide a satisfactory Criminal Record Search Certificate as a result of a repeated criminal records search will not be permitted to continue to perform any Work.
