place in accordance with the contract documents.

## **GENERAL QUESTIONS AND RESPONSES FROM BIDDERS TO DATE**

1	Who will pay Building Permit GC or Owner?	As per GC 6.12, the Contractor will be responsible for all required building permits.
2	If we encountered any contaminated soil during construction, whose responsibility is it to remove?	Impacted soil is not expected on site. If impact soil is encountered during construction, its removal will be addressed via a Change Order.
