QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

- **Q1** Is there additional information on the abandoned "TS line" running through the western edge of the site as shown on the provided drawing?
 - A1 No.
- **Q2** Please confirm the existence of a 3.41 meter fire exit as shown on the provided drawing. Please provide the parameters for keeping this area clear.
 - A2 There is a fire exit as shown on the provided drawings (west façade of 145 Market). The interpretation installation shall not block safe exiting of occupants from 145 Market.
- Q3 What is the exact or assumed height of 145 Market Avenue?
 - A3 The height of 145 Market is 50 feet.
- **Q4** Please provide CAD base files for the competition.
 - A4 No additional CAD base files are available for the competition.
- **Q5** Authority to Carry on Business.- If the submission is being made by an individual or team of individuals and not a business are they allowed to make a submission for this competition?
 - A5 The proponent shall be a registered business or affiliated with a registered business.
- **Q6** Team information is weighted as 20%, please provide a further breakdown of how the team information category will be ranked/judged?
 - A6 Team information will be evaluated considering response to B11, the experience of the team on projects of similar size and complexity as well as other information requested.

Q7 If selected for Phase 2 is expansion of the team allowable?

A7 Yes.

Q8 Will both the evaluation of the Team Information and the Design Proposal be completed by the Jury?

A8 Yes.

Q9 Qualifications - Is the intention of the proposal that the competition team include a contractor capable of implementing the design?

A9 Yes.

- **Q10** Please confirm the requirements under B14.4. It appears as unnecessary in the context of a design competition.
 - A10 The requirements under B14.4 are necessary because the design competition includes building the interpretive installation.
- **Q11** Please clarify use of the word "Contractor" in the proposal.
 - A11 For definition of Contractor please refer to C0.1.1
- **Q12** Please clarify B23.11. Should it read, "The highest semi-finalist shall receive the full 40 points?
 - A12 No, B23.11 pertains to Detailed Prices. "Further to B23.10 a, the Detailed Prices shall be evaluated with a weighing of 40 points out of a total of 100 possible points. As such, the lowest semi-finalist shall receive the full 40 points..."
- **Q13** Please clarify how Detailed Prices will be evaluated in Phase 2. Is it the vendor's intention to select the lowest possible price?
 - A13 Please refer to B23.11 for evaluation of Detailed Prices. The semi-finalist with the lowest Detailed Price shall receive the full 40 points.
