# **QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS**

- Q) What is the size of the watermain to be abandoned? Material for this range in price are size specific.
- A) While the actual diameter of the water line is not known, please use an assumed diameter of 100 mm for pricing purposes. The revision to line item A.28 i) of the Form B is part of this addendum.
- Q) Is 100 mm granular sub base material for the retaining wall found on S5-Addendum 1 paid for in line item A.4 of the Form B?
- A) Yes, it should be paid in line item A.4 and not included in the Retaining Wall Lump Sum cost.
- Q) Are the excavation, fill, base course, and geotextile shown on drawings S9, S12 and S13 as part of the structural concrete pads, paid in structural lump sum items or in A Roadworks line items of the Form B?
- A) All of these noted structural items should include the components required for construction in their lump sum pricing under the items: B.2 ii) Structural Slabs (Bin Slabs and Cardboard Collection Slab), B.2 iii) Prefabricated Kiosk Foundation and B.2 iv) HHW Building Concrete Items (excluding Piles).
