

Update No 6. Bid Opportunity 973-2016:

Update No. 6 to revise anticipated posting RFQ date.

The North End Sewage Treatment Plant (NEWPCC) is the City of Winnipeg's largest sewage treatment plant at 302 MLD and provides approximately 70% of the City's sewage treatment, serving a population of 404,000. The City is in the process of upgrading plant technology to meet both requirements of a Manitoba Regulatory License, and to replace end-of-life equipment. Design will accommodate 2037 influent flows and loads with provisions for future expansion to 2067 population forecasts. The project also includes biosolids processing and wet weather flow treatment upgrades.

The NEWPCC Upgrade preliminary design work is continuing and achieving project milestones.

The procurement strategy is being reviewed to break the project into several smaller DB packages.

The details of the packages and the timing of release are unknown at this time.
