Project for projects of similar complexity, scope and value, including the principals-in-charge, consultant's Project Manager, managers of the key disciplines and lead

designers. Include educational background and degrees, professional

designations, job title, years of experience in current position, years of experience in design and construction, and years of experience with existing employer. Roles

of each of the Key Personnel in the Project should be identified in the

organizational chart referred to in B10.1. For each person identified, list at least two comparable projects in which they have played a primary role. If a project selected for a key person is included in B9, provide only the project name and the role of the key person. For other projects provide the description of the project, role of the person, project owner and reference information (one current name with telephone number per project). The experience of the Public Engagement Lead **should preferably** include: confirmation of IAP2 membership, and completion of IAP2 or related public engagement courses, specifying the year of completion of the IAP2

Foundations/Certificate courses.

Revise: D6.13.1(a) to read: The public engagement process should preferably be based on IAP2 principles

and best practices (see http://iap2canada.ca/).

Revise: D6.13.1(b) to read: The experience of the Public Engagement lead should **preferably** include:

confirmation of IAP2 membership, and completion of IAP2 or related public

engagement courses, specifying the year of completion of the IAP2

Foundations/Certificate courses.
