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#### **PART B – BIDDING PROCEDURES**

Revise B2.1 to read: The Submission Deadline is 4:00 p.m. Winnipeg time October 24, 2017

#### **PART D – SUPPLEMENTAL CONDITIONS**

Replace: D8.1 to read:

The Contractor shall provide and maintain the following insurance coverage:

- (a) commercial general liability insurance, in the amount of at least five million dollars (\$5,000,000.00) inclusive, with The City of Winnipeg added as an additional insured; such liability policy to also contain a cross-liability clause, non-owned automobile liability, sudden and accidental pollution and products and completed operations cover, to remain in place at all times during the performance of the Work;
- (b) the certificate of insurance must expressly state, "operations to include the delivery of chemicals"

Replace: D8.2 to read:

The Contractor shall provide or cause the rail car owner to provide and maintain the following insurance

- (a) Pollution legal liability in an amount not less than \$1,000,000 per claim for on-site clean-up expenses, bodily injury and property damage and emergency response costs at all times during the performance of the Work and for six (6) months after completion.

Add: D8.6: to read:

Deductibles shall be borne by the Contractor

#### **PART E – SPECIFICATIONS**

Replace: E5.1 to read:

E5.1 In the event of a rail car derailment along the City owned railway, or the spill, leakage, release or escape of any chemical from the rail car, the Contractor shall in cooperation with the governing body be prepared to mobilize and assist in the transfer of chemical from a derailed car to a replacement car. If required the City will enact its Emergency Response Plan by calling Manitoba Sustainable Development, Emergency Response Program twenty-four (24) hour emergency telephone number **204 944 4888**.
