## PART D - SUPPLEMENTAL CONDITIONS

Revise: D9.1 to read: If the Contractor fails to achieve delivery of the goods within the time specified in D8.1

Delivery the Contractor shall pay the City **two hundred and fifty dollars** (\$250) per Calendar Day for each and every Calendar Day until the goods have been delivered.

Add: **D9 TRAINING** 

- D9.1 The Contract Administrator or designated alternate will contact the Contractor to organize
  - training after the Contract has been awarded.
- D9.2 The Contractor shall be responsible for providing training for City of Winnipeg personnel. The training will be at the Contractor's expense.
- D9.3 Training shall take place within thirty (30) Calendar Days after delivery, at 1539 Waverley Street, Winnipeg, MB. at a time that is agreeable to the Contract Administrator.
- D9.4 The training sessions shall be used for familiarization and orientation of the equipment and/or goods to the satisfaction of the Insect Control Branch Staff. Training may include power point presentations, class room training, webinars, and hands on training. Specifics to the training sessions may vary depending on the equipment and/or goods.
- D9.5 The training shall include the following:
  - (a) Daily pre-trip inspection items and basic operator maintenance requirements;
  - (b) Familiarization of all controls and their functions;
  - (c) Demonstration of equipment operation with all applicable attachments;
  - (d) In depth instruction of all associated software; and
  - (e) Any other training/familiarization requirements that is specific to the unit.

Clause numbering of Section D will change as a result of this addition.
