PART B – REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATION INFORMATION

- Revise: B4.3 to read: After receiving the Submissions to this RFQ, the City will review all Submissions received and shortlist the most qualified Proponents. Only those Proponents on the shortlist will be invited to further submit a more detailed Proposal.

- Revise: B5.1(d) to read: The City reserves the right to add or delete Contractors during the period stated in B2.1 in the best interest to the City.

- Add: B 29 **INSURANCE**
- B29.1 The Pre-qualified Bidder shall provide and maintain the following insurance coverage:
 - (a) commercial general liability insurance, in the amount of at least two million dollars (\$2,000,000.00) all inclusive, with The City of Winnipeg being added as an additional insured, with a cross-liability clause, such liability policy to also contain a contractual liability, an unlicensed motor vehicle liability and a products and completed operations endorsement to remain in place at all times during the performance of the Work and throughout the warranty period;
 - (b) automobile liability insurance for owned and non-owned automobiles used for or in connection with the Work in the amount of at least two million dollars (\$2,000,000.00) at all times during the performance of the Work and until the date of Total Performance;

- D8.2 Deductibles shall be borne by the Contractor.

- D8.3 Pre-qualified Bidders shall provide the Contract Administrator with a certificate of insurance of each policy, in a form satisfactory to the Contract Administrator no later than seven (7) Calendar Days from notification by the Contract Administrator. The said insurance shall be in place with the City, at all times during the period stated in B2.1.

- D8.3.1 The certificate of insurance for the commercial general liability insurance must clearly state “operations to include demolition work” and if applicable “wet demolition”

- D8.4 The Pre-qualified Bidder shall not cancel, materially alter, or cause each policy to lapse without providing at least thirty (30) Calendar Days prior written notice to the Contract Administrator.
