Question 1:	Will the preliminary design documents be made available as part of the RFQ process? It
	would be helpful to know how much of the preliminary design and equipment selection has
	been done and how much is left to be done
Answer 1:	It was not intended to release this information at the RFQ stage. However, you could submit an RFI and we will take it under advisement.
Question 2:	Is there a preliminary cost estimate for the project?
Answer 2:	The RFQ indicates a budget for both this NEWPCC Upgrade: Headworks Facilities project and the NEWPCC Upgrade Power Supply project. This amount includes all City costs not only the design build costs.
Question 3:	Is there a stated affordability cap?
Answer 3:	The City has yet to determine if there will be an affordability cap. If an affordability cap will be used, details will be provided in the RFP.
Question 4:	Is the DCS migration for the entire plant, not just the Headworks portion?
Answer 4:	Yes, the DCS migration would encompass the entire NEWPCC plant.
Question 5:	Will we be given copies of the presentation slides?
Answer 5:	Yes, they will be posted on the City's website.
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Question 6:	What does the commencement date of December 2020 represent? The start of site works?
Answer 6:	The commencement date of December 2020 is the anticipated date of entering into the contract. Presumably the Design Builder would commence with design prior to site works.
