### PART A – PROPOSAL SUBMISSION

Replace: 81-2020 Addendum 1 - Proposal Submission with **81-2020 Addendum 2 - Proposal Submission**. The following is a summary of changes incorporated in the replacement Proposal Submission:

Form B(R2): Revised the Approximate Quantity for Item No. 19.

Page numbering on some forms may be changed as a result.

### PART D – SUPPLEMENTAL CONDITIONS

**Delete: D10.3**

**Add: D18.2** Cylinder(s) shall come with a 15 year comprehensive warranty that does not require activation registration nor is contingent on the completion of any particular mandatory overhaul or preventative maintenance, other than regulatory requirements (e.g., 5 year hydrostatic testing) and manufacturer's recommended maintenance.

### PART E – SPECIFICATIONS

**Revise: E2.1(g) to read:** Approved to NIOSH 42 CFR part 84, the facepiece shall meet the penetration and impact requirements, including compliance with ANSI Z87.1 – **2010 or newer**;

**Revise: E3.2(f) to read:** Possess Bluetooth enable radio integration compatible with current **WFPS Harris XL200 portable radios and able to upgrade/modify to other radios if required in the future.**

**Add: E3.2(f)(i)** **The Winnipeg Fire Paramedic Service has 144 units of Harris XL200 portable radios.**

**Revise: E5.2(q) to read:** **head harness;**

**Delete: E5.2(y)**

**Revise: E8.1(o) to read:** Come with an individual **fabric (cloth)** protective bag for each face piece.

**Revise: E14.2 to read:** When the PASS device goes into pre-alarm, the user shall be notified **visually via the HUD display along with external lighting and audible tones.**

## **QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS**

Q1: E3, E4, E13, If Winnipeg Fire has any equipment that is backwards compatible to the SCBA, would you consider using such equipment?

**A1: No, all equipment shall be new, refer to the Request for Proposal.**

Q2: E5.2(y), Please clarify if the Radio Mounting Bracket is specific to Winnipeg Fire Radios or a Face Piece Mounted Bracket for a Voice Amplification Device.

**A2: Refer to Addendum 2, E5.2(y).**

Q3: E8.1(o) What style of protective bag would Winnipeg Fire want? (Plastic, Cloth, Nylon)

**A3: Refer to Addendum 2, E8.1(o).**

Q4: For E2.1 (g) Approved to NIOSH 42 CFR part 84, the facepiece shall meet the penetration and impact requirements, including compliance with ANSI Z87.1 - 2015

Since NIOSH does not specify which standard to use, will WFPS accept conformance to an alternate sample, such as EN166?

Please note that NIOSH states: §84.76 Facepieces; eyepieces; minimum requirements.

**A4: Refer to Addendum 2, E2.1(g).**

Q5: For E 3.2 (f) Possess Bluetooth enabled radio integration compatible with multiple radio brands, specifically the current WFPS Harris XL200 portable radios

Can they strike: "multiple radio brands" (what if a vendor is only compatible with Harris?)

**A5: Refer to Addendum 2, E3.2(f).**

Q6: May we ask how man XL200 portable radios are assigned to fire department operations?

(We would need to know how many lapel mics/speakers to provide.)

**A6: Refer to Addendum 2, E3.2(f)(i).**

Q7: Does WFPS expect to have any communications hardware or software in the next 2 years?

as per 3.2 (j) Be upgradeable to any updated communications hardware and/or software including but not limited to inter-company communications that may become available within 18 months from date of award.

**A7: E3.2(j) refers to any potential upgrades or changes in the supplied SCBA and accompanying technology, not WFPS specific equipment.**

Q8: Do we need to ask how many fit test adapters are needed?

**A8: Refer to Addendum 2 – Proposal Submission, Item No. 19.**

Q9: Would WFPS accept an alternate to E14.2?

**A9: Refer to Addendum 2, E14.2.**

Q10: Can you clarify D10.3?

**A10: Refer to Addendum 2, D10.3.**

Q11: Is it possible to change D18.2?

**A11: Refer to Addendum 2, D18.2.**

Q12: In the RFP document's Specifications section, pg. 4 of 5, E10. Facepiece Harness, E10.1, it states that facepiece assembly shall have 4- or 5- points of suspension.

In the same document on pg. 3 of 5, Section E5. Replacement Parts, E5.2, (q), it asks for a Head Harness "5-point". (also # 38 on Form B (R1): Prices)

Could you please confirm if all of the facepieces are to be 5-point or just those listed in the replacement parts section.
