## **QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS**

#### **REVISED Q&A FROM ADDENDUM 1:**

Q1: Section D3.4.b.iv notes that the general contractor is to resume responsibility and costs as the "General Contractor" for all General Conditions and associated work for all portions of work and construction requirements not covered under sub-trade contracts. Please provide further definition of costs which are to be included within the item 2 Construction management fee for Phase 2 - Construction as noted above for general conditions. Based on the project information available within the request for proposal there is insufficient information available to determine an effective project schedule, phasing plan, and site logistics plan which must be incorporated as part of the project general expense.

A1: Costs which are to be included within item 2 Construction management fee for Phase 2 includes all costs that would be incurred by the Construction Manager for the completion of the work, including but not limited to labour & materials, permits, insurance, bonding, site safety and security, and temporary facilities. In reference to schedule as per B13.3 The Proponent should provide a sample construction schedule for one project referenced in Section D. From this schedule, provide an example(s) of a scheduling challenge and what actions were taken to mitigate the challenge(s).
