QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

- Q1: Can we propose the submission deadline be extended to April 21, 2023 at 12:00 noon Winnipeg time, to make up time lost at Easter stat holidays?
- A1: The City cannot extend the submission deadline.
- Q2: B6.1.2 - (iii) - Support an open-source type platform to allow users to access the source code, make changes and distribute it as they see fit.
Will your own internal IT want to make changes to source code? This is cautionary because of the impact of changing code on one item, may impact another item. Our team are experts in managing source code and perhaps a collaboration would suffice?
- A2: Yes, the proponent team may provide clear guidelines and documentation that explain the platform architecture and coding standards to facilitate collaboration. Additionally, they may need to establish a transparent process for reviewing and accepting contributions from the City, to ensure that any changes made are carefully vetted and integrated into the Moodle code platform.
- Q3: B6.1.2 - (ix) - Multitenancy support to enable the creation of separate LMS instances for different departments or groups within an organization, to allow administrators to customize the LMS for each group's specific needs while maintaining centralized management.
If we have the capability to have multitenancy in one instance, would that suffice?
- A3: Yes.
- Q4: B6.1.2 - (xiii) The ability to migrate existing training courses, records and certifications from existing City of Winnipeg LMS systems like PeopleSoft, Moodle, SmarterU, etc.
What is the format for the training courses, records and certifications for SmarterU and PeopleSoft?
- A4: These courses are generally created as SCORM packages from tools like iSpring or Adobe Captivate. Other than that, we also have external learning content in various formats, such as video files, PowerPoint presentations, and PDF documents.
