PART B – BIDDING PROCEDURES

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Q1: Will licensing will be required to expand the existing system to accommodate these new access control points?
A1: No, licensing will not be required.

Q2: What access platform are the boards to be integrated with?
A2: The City of Winnipeg already has an access platform in place, Pegasys (P2000). The City of Winnipeg will manage programming of the P2000 software. The Contractor will be responsible for ensuring that the new boards match the existing configuration, (IP Addresses, Expansion Board Address, Device Order).

Q3: What the City is using as Head End/Access Platform Software to run the access control network?
A3: The current Software is Pegasys (P2000).
