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# **PART E - SPECIFICATIONS**

## **GENERAL**

## E1. GENERAL

E1.1 These Specifications shall apply to the Work.

## E2. GOODS

- E2.1 The Contractor shall supply and deliver a floor scrubber (walk behind) with the salient features in accordance with Form N: Data Specification Sheet, and the requirements hereinafter specified.
- E2.2 The Contractor shall supply the equipment and all components and all features which are normally considered to be standard on that equipment, unless specifically excluded. Any material or components not herein specifically mentioned or included, but which may be required complete, and place the equipment in successful operation, shall be furnished by the Contractor as though specifically mentioned in these Contract documents.
- E2.3 The Contractor shall assure that the components of the equipment supplied will operate as specified. The Contractor shall make all necessary and required modifications to facilitate functionality.

# E3. MANUALS

- E3.1 The Contractor shall insure the following manuals be supplied with the item when delivered, and shall contain a section in **English**:
  - (a) operator's manual one (1) set required; and
  - (b) parts and service manuals, including preventative maintenance schedules for the life of the unit(s) one (1) set required for each unit.

## E4. DEMONSTRATION OF PRODUCT

- E4.1 Upon a request from the Contract Administrator the Bidder will have five (5) Calendar Days to arrange a demonstration of the equipment purposed in their Bid.
- E4.1.1 The Contractor shall arrange for the delivery and pick up of the equipment at the site.
- E4.1.2 The demonstration shall take no longer than two (2) hours, for the Contract Administrator or his/her designate to evaluate the floor scrubber.

## E5. PERFORMANCE RELIABILITY

E5.1 The Contractor shall assure the City of Winnipeg that the responsibility for the design of the floor scrubber, it's performance and reliability shall rest upon the Manufacturer.

## E6. LITERATURE

E6.1 The Bidder shall submit within three (3) Business Days of a request by the Contract Administrator, current descriptive, detailed literature on the equipment being bid.

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# E7. DELIVERY

- E7.1 The floor scrubber shall be delivered freight pre-paid, f.o.b. to 644 Parkdale Street, Winnipeg, Manitoba, serviced and ready for operation, within fifteen (15) Calendar Days or sooner from the date of notification of the award.
- E7.2 The Contract Administrator shall be notified within two (2) Business Days at (204) 986-5328, prior to delivery.

# E8. TRAINING

E8.1 The Contractor shall provide at their expense, up to two (2) hours of operational and maintenance training by qualified staff for the City of Winnipeg Personnel. The training shall be conducted in a separate or combined session/s for each group of personnel. The session/s shall be sufficient in duration and shall provide adequate familiarization and orientation on the floor scrubber, to the satisfaction of the Contract Administrator.
