DETAILED SPECIFICATIONS 04 - 004

LEASE of 28 HORSEPOWER OUTFRONT MOWERS

(five (5) year lease)

1.0 INTENT

1.1 It is the intent of these specifications to describe

Twenty-eight (28) horsepower four wheel drive outfront mowers with rear discharge and other equipment and features as specified herein.

This tender is structured to procure 28 horsepower outfront mowers for the City of Winnipeg under a five(5) year, full warranty lease agreement. The City reserves the right to extend the contract beyond the initial period of five(5) years for up to and including two(2)additional option years, with a full warranty lease agreement which will also form part of this contract.

1.2 Eligible models acceptable to the City for new machines are

John Deere 1445

Kubota F - 3060

Toro 328 - D

- 1.3 The mowers shall be a 2004 model year or newer.
- 1.4 The mowers, including the mower decks and snowblower, shall be the manufacturer's latest model as may be modified by these specifications. The mowers shall be furnished complete and ready for use. Any parts not specifically mentioned but which are required to complete and place the mowers in successful operation shall be furnished as though specifically mentioned in these specifications. The complete mower units, and all parts thereof, shall conform in strength and quality of material and workmanship, to the best standards and engineering practice of the industry.
- 1.5 The ratings specified herein state the minimum values acceptable to the City, not implying that these values are sufficient for the design of the particular unit being bid.
- 1.6 The contract outlined for the acquisition of new mowers provided under the five(5) year lease agreement for all items specified in Form: B Schedule of Prices will be awarded as a whole (Total Bid Price), and not by item.

2.0 EQUIPMENT SERVICING, MAINTENANCE and REPAIR

- 2.1 The City shall be responsible for the following items for equipment leased under this Contract:
 - Insurance
 - Oil and oil filter changes with O.E.M. products as recommended by the Contractor
 - All regular scheduled maintenance including regular service adjustments as recommended by the
 equipment manufacturer. This would include, but not limited to, such items as blade sharpening and belt
 adjustments etc.
 - Repair of damage to the equipment where damage has proven to have been caused by negligence on the part of the City.
 - Normal operating and maintenance supplies including daily and weekly maintenance such as greasing and cleaning.

- Repair or replacement of damaged tires due to road hazards;
- Replacement of tires due to normal wear.
- Fuel
- 2.2 The Contractor shall be responsible for the following items for equipment leased under this Contract:
 - All warranty issues which would include but not limited to repairs due to mechanical failure or malfunction
 - Towing costs (if unit is immobile), if related to warranty issues
 - All parts and labour costs (excluding items listed in Section 2.1)

3.0 EQUIPMENT ROTATION

- 3.1 The successful Bidder may at any time exchange any number of mowers previously provided, with new mowers, each with a newly offered, full warranty lease agreement covering the remainder of , or duration of the Contract, which would include the possibility of two(2) added option years.
- 3.2 The successful Bidder may at any time, rotate the mowers within the City's fleet at the discretion of the Bidder.

4.0 EQUIPMENT STORAGE

- 4.1 In reference to the storage of the mowers in the "off" season or winter months, the Contractor shall choose one of the following three(3) options:
 - a) The Contractor may pick up <u>"all"</u> the mowers on the first business day after October 15 and store them in their own facility. The mowers must be returned ready for operation to the City by no later than the first business day after April 15 of the following year.
 - b) The Contractor may pick up <u>"a partial quantity"</u> of the mowers on the first business day after October 15 and store them in their own facility. The City will retain the balance of the quantity of the mowers and will provide storage.
 - The quantity of mowers picked up by the Contractor must be returned ready for operation to the City by no later than the first business day after April 15 of the following year.
 - c) The City will store "all" the mowers on behalf of the Contractor.
- 4.2 If the Contractor chooses to store any portion or all of the mowers on City property (b or c above), the Contractor shall be made aware of the following criteria:
 - The City will store the mowers on several secured sites. The mowers will be exposed to the natural environmental elements on the unenclosed sites. The mowers will not be covered. The Contractor may be allowed to visit the sites and cover the mowers, at the Contractors time and expense.
- 4.3 The Contractor shall choose one of the storage options outlined in Clause 4.1 above (a, b, c), by completion of this specification clause.

5.0 TERMS of LEASE

5.1 The length of the lease shall be **sixty (60) months, commencing from the first business day following April 15/2004**. The equipment shall be made available and operational upon delivery to the City, each year between the years of 2004-2008 inclusive.

- The City reserves the right to extend the lease a further twenty-four (24) months. depending on equipment requirements, at the same lease rate bid for Items 1, 2 and 3 (all items) on Form B: PRICES. The City will notify the Contractor fifteen (15) calendar days prior to the termination date of the lease period if an extension of the lease is required.
- 5.3 Contractors shall state the rental cost per month, as indicated on Form B: PRICES. The monthly rate shall include the cost of all warranty repair work including replacement of any components that fail during normal operation of the machine.
- 5.4 For equipment leased under this contract, the Lessor shall repair or rectify any defects in workmanship, construction and materials, and shall repair or replace without additional cost to the City, any component that has become defective and not proven to have been caused by negligence on the part of the user throughout the entire duration of the lease Contract.
- 5.5 Further to GC 8.02, the lease agreement shall be terminated at any time at the discretion of the Contract Administrator due to poor performance or continual breakdowns.
- 5.5.1 Due to the termination of the lease agreement as per clause 5.5 the City of Winnipeg shall not be responsible for the balance of payment. The lease agreement shall be prorated accordingly.
- The equipment shall be delivered, serviced and ready for operation, F.O.B. to the Fleet Management Agency, 770 Ross Avenue, Winnipeg, Manitoba, no later than 9:00 am on the lease commencement date.
- 5.7 The Contractor shall acknowledge compliance with the specifications and requirements of Clauses 1.0 to 5.6 inclusive stated above.
