## PART E - SPECIFICATIONS

### GENERAL

#### E1. GENERAL

E1.1 These Specifications shall apply to the Work.

#### E2. GOODS

E2.1 The Contractor shall supply and deliver bus shelter glass in accordance with the requirements hereinafter specified.

E2.2 Item No's. 1 – 4 shall be an clear (Armolite) tempered glass supplied with a one (1") inch blue safety stripe across the width of the glass at the midway point.

E2.2.1 The thickness of the clear tempered glass shall be 5 mil, and all edges shall be flat ground, the sizes are as follows;

- (a) 18  $\frac{3}{4}$ " (w) x 28  $\frac{3}{4}$ " (l)
- (b) 18  $\frac{3}{4}$ " (w) x 31  $\frac{1}{4}$ " (l)
- (c) 18  $\frac{3}{4}$ " (w) x 32  $\frac{3}{4}$ " (l)
- (d) 18  $\frac{3}{4}$ " (w) x 41  $\frac{1}{4}$ " (l)

E2.2.2 Item No's. 5 - 7 shall be an clear (Armolite) tempered glass 10 mil, in thickness and all edges shall be flat ground, the sizes are as follows;

- (a) 28" (w) x 82" (l)
- (b) 44" (w) x 82" (l)
- (c) 57  $\frac{3}{4}$ " (w) x 82" (l)

#### E3. DELIVERY

E3.1 Goods shall be delivered on an "as required" basis during the term of the Contract, f.o.b. destination, freight prepaid, to:

E3.1.1 Goods shall be delivered within five (5) Business Days of the placing of an order, except where otherwise agreed at the time of ordering.

E3.2 Goods shall be delivered between 7:30 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. on Business Days.

E3.3 The Contractor shall off-load goods as directed at the delivery location.

E3.4 The bus shelter glass shall be shipped in crates or padded racks, as Transit will not accept shipment of loose glass.
