SPECIFICATIONS

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GENERAL

E1. GENERAL

E1.1 These Specifications shall apply to the Work.

E2. SERVICES

E2.1 The Contractor shall supply all of the labour, materials and equipment necessary to board-up and/or secure buildings damaged by fires, vandalism, break & entering, and Police investigations where required by the Winnipeg Police Service, in accordance with the requirements hereinafter specified. Building board-ups and or securing buildings may be private residences, apartment blocks or businesses

E2.2 Work for other City of Winnipeg Departments is excluded from this Contract.

E2.3 The major components of the Work are as follows:

- (a) Item No. 1 Service calls consists of all labour and mileage required to perform the Work during a Working Day as defined in clause D4.1(d).
- (b) Item No. 2 – Service calls consists of all labour and mileage required to perform the Work After Hours as defined in clause D4.1(e)
- (c) Item No. 3 - Lock replacement/lock and hasp shall include the cost of each lock and hasp and any other materials required to install them.
- (d) Item No. 4 Plywood shall consist of the plywood and all other material required for the board-up and securing of the building. To include but not be limited to plywood, nails and screws. Plywood should be 4" x 8" x 3/8". If, during the Contract period, a partial piece of plywood is used for board-up of a building the cost per sheet shall be prorated to reflect the approximate quantity of plywood used. E.g. if only ½ of a sheet of plywood is used the price shown on Form B: Prices item 4 shall be divided in half.

E2.4 The Work shall be done on an "as required" basis at anytime twenty-four (24) hours a day, seven days a week during the term of the Contract at various Sites within the City of Winnipeg limits.

E2.4.1 Work shall commence within one (1) hour of the placing of an order, except where otherwise agreed at the time of ordering.

E2.4.2 Work shall be completed as soon as possible.

E2.4.3 The Contractor shall promptly report any delay or change to an agreed commencement or completion date to the User.

E2.4.4 The type and quantity of Work to be performed under this Contract shall be as authorized from time to time by the Contract Administrator and/or Users.

E2.4.5 Subject to GC.4.08, the City shall have no obligation under the Contract to purchase any quantity of any item in excess of its actual operational requirements.
