1.0 INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETION OF SPECIFICATIONS

- 1.1 The Police Sport Utility Vehicles shall be a new 2007 or 2008 model year. The vehicle shall be furnished complete and ready for use by the Contractor. All parts not specifically mentioned but which are required to complete and place the vehicle into successful operation shall be furnished as though specifically mentioned in these specifications.
- 1.2 It will be the responsibility of the Bidder to inform the City of any errors or omissions in these specifications, for under this Contract the Contractor shall be held responsible for the satisfactory operational function of the vehicle.
- 1.3 All items in these specifications must be answered indicating compliance or non-compliance. **Bidders** shall state "yes" for compliance or state deviation, or give a reply where requested to do so. Deviations shall be clearly stated and fully detailed. Alternatives will be considered subject to evaluation.
- 1.4 Each bidder is required to fill in every blank. Failure to do so may be used as a basis for rejection of bid.
- 1.5 All applicable SAE standards form an integral part of these specifications and shall have precedence in any conflict concerning minimum acceptable standards.
- 1.6 The completed unit and all its components shall comply with all C.M.V.S.S. and Manitoba Highway Traffic Act regulations and requirements including, but not limited to, a Manitoba Government Inspection with Safety Sticker on the driver's side window.

2.0 SERVICE FACILITY

2.1 For the purpose of warranty repairs, the supplier shall have an authorized service facility located within 10 km of the boundaries of the City of Winnipeg. The facility, or a portion thereof, shall be dedicated to the service and maintenance of the type equipment being offered. Further to B9.1, Bidders shall provide a description of the service facility including, but not limited to, number of qualified service staff, years of service experience, and general service capabilities within three (3) Business Days upon request of the Contract Administrator.

3.0 <u>ELIGIBLE MODELS:</u> FORD ESCAPE XLT OR EQUIVALENT IN ACCORDANCE TO B.5 SUBSTITUTES STATED HEREIN.

4.1	The Contractor shall supply the following manuals (in English) upon delivery of the vehicles:
4.1.1	Operator's manual – one (1) per vehicle.
4.1.2	Technical Service manuals, Paper copy preferred - one (1) set.
4.2	Data Collection Sheets- Data collection sheets to be completely filled out. See clause D.6 (PMDCS)
5.0	WARRANTY
5.1	The Contractor shall warrant the vehicle and all parts thereof, against any defects of workmanship, construction and materials, and agrees to repair or replace without cost to the City any article that has become defective and not proven to have been caused by negligence on the part of the user for a period of (3) years or 60,000 km, "bumper to bumper", no deductible.
5.2	In the event of a failure on the part of the Contractor to repair or replace any article during the warranty period within five (5) business days from the date of notification, the City may have the work performed by others and offset the cost against any money due, or that may become due to the Contractor, or if there is money due, the Contractor agrees to pay the City such cost.

- 5.3 The responsibility for the design of the complete equipment, its performance and reliability shall rest upon the Contractor.
- 5.4 The term "repeated failures" as determined by the Contract Administrator, as used herein is defined to mean that the same component, subassembly, or assembly develops repeated defects, breakdowns and/or malfunctions rendering the apparatus inoperative, or requiring repeated shop correction, service and/or replacement during the warranty period applicable for said component, subassembly, or assembly. Minor items or ordinary service adjustments are not included, or considered under the scope of "repeated failures", as well as other factors, such as operational damage due to accidents, misuse or lack of proper maintenance, service and lubrication attention by not following the manufacturer's preventative maintenance schedule.
- 5.5 Where the vehicle develops "repeated failures" in service, the Contractor shall make any necessary engineering changes, repairs, alterations or modifications in order to guarantee reliability of performance, at no cost to the City, including all incidental costs, with a reapplied, full warranty as described in clause 5.4.

6.0 TRAINING

6.1 The Contractor shall be required to provide training (at the Contractor's expense) for the City of Winnipeg maintenance and operating personnel.

The training shall be divided into two separate sessions, one for maintenance personnel and one for operating personnel. The training shall be conducted in separate or combined sessions for each group of personnel.

The duration of the sessions shall be as long as required for adequate familiarization and orientation of the equipment to the satisfaction of the Contract Administrator.

The training shall be conducted within two (2) calendar weeks from the date of delivery and shall be coordinated through the Contract Administrator.

The training shall be conducted in Winnipeg at a time and location designated by the Contract Administrator.

Pricing should be based on two (2) business days for maintenance personnel and two (2) business days for operating personnel.

Note: The first payment of the contract on the equipment will not be issued until successful completion of training has been conducted to the satisfaction of the Contract Administrator.
