1.0 SCOPE

- 1.1 The **Supply & Delivery the Mini Skid-Steer shall be 2007 or 2008 model year.** The vehicle shall be furnished complete and ready for use by the Contractor. All parts not specifically mentioned but which are required to complete and place the vehicle into successful operation shall be furnished as though specifically mentioned in these specifications.
- 1.2 The **Mini Skid-Steer** shall be furnished complete and ready for use. All parts not specifically mentioned, but which are required to complete and place the unit in successful operation, shall be furnished as though specifically mentioned in these specifications. The complete unit, and all parts thereof, shall conform in strength and quality of material and workmanship, to the best standards and engineering practice of the industry.
- 1.3 It will be the responsibility of the Bidder to inform the City of any deficiencies in these specifications, for under this Contract the Contractor shall be held responsible for the design, performance, reliability and satisfactory operational function of the units.

2.0 STANDARDS

- 2.1 All applicable SAE standards form an integral part of these specifications and shall have precedence in any conflict concerning minimum acceptable standards.
- 2.2 The completed unit and all its components shall comply with all C.M.V.S.S. Canadian Motor Vehicle Safety Standards.

3.0 QUALIFICATIONS OF MANUFACTURER / CONTRACTOR

- 3.1 The Contractor shall be an authorized distributor/supplier of the **Mini Skid-Steer** equipment being bid.
- 3.2 The Contractor shall have an authorized service facility located within 10 km of the boundaries of the City of Winnipeg. The facility, or a portion thereof, shall be dedicated to the service and maintenance of the equipment being offered. Further to B9.1, Bidders shall provide a description of the service facility including, but not limited to, number of qualified service staff, years of service experience of the equipment being offered, and general service capabilities. A description of the service facility shall be provided within 3-calendar days upon request of the Contract Administrator.
- 3.3 If a suitable warranty facility is not available within 10 km of the boundaries of the City of Winnipeg, the Bidder may propose that warranty work be performed by the City of Winnipeg Repair Facility. Any Work performed by the City of Winnipeg Repair Facility shall be charged to the Contractor at the Facility's shop rate in effect at the time the work is performed (for example, shop rate for 2007: \$80.00/hour regular time, \$105.00/hr overtime and callout.

4.0 <u>INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETION OF SPECIFICATIONS</u>

4.1 All items in these specifications must be answered indicating compliance or non-compliance.

Bidders shall state, "yes" for compliance or state deviation, or give a reply where requested
