#### 1.0 INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETION OF SPECIFICATIONS

- 1.1 The **600 lbs. Capacity Utility Vehicle shall be a 2007 or 2008 model year**. The vehicles shall be furnished complete and ready for use by the Contractor. All parts not specifically mentioned but which are required to complete and place the vehicle into successful operation shall be furnished as though specifically mentioned in these specifications.
- 1.2 It will be the responsibility of the Bidder to inform the City of any errors or omissions in these specifications, for under this Contract the Contractor shall be held responsible for the satisfactory operational function of the vehicle.
- 1.3 All items in these specifications must be answered indicating compliance or non-compliance. **Bidders shall state "yes" for compliance or state deviation**, or give a reply where requested to do so. Deviations shall be clearly stated and fully detailed. Alternatives will be considered subject to evaluation.
- 1.4 Each bidder is required to fill in every blank. Failure to do so may be used as a basis for rejection of bid.
- 1.5 All applicable SAE standards form an integral part of these specifications and shall have precedence in any conflict concerning minimum acceptable standards.
- 1.6 The completed unit and all its components shall comply with all C.M.V.S.S. and Manitoba Highway Traffic Act regulations and requirements.

#### 2.0 SERVICE FACILITY

- 2.1 For the purpose of warranty repairs, the supplier shall have an authorized service facility located within 10 kilometres of the boundaries of the City of Winnipeg. The facility, or a portion thereof, shall be dedicated to the service and maintenance of the type equipment being offered. Further to B9.1, Bidders shall provide a description of the service facility including, but not limited to, number of qualified service staff, years of service experience, and general service capabilities within three (3) Business Days upon request of the Contract Administrator.
- 2.2 If a suitable warranty facility is not available within 10 km of the boundaries of the City of Winnipeg, the Bidder may propose that the City of Winnipeg Repair Facility perform warranty work. Any Work performed by the City of Winnipeg Repair Facility shall be charged to the Contractor at the Facility's shop rate in effect at the time the work is performed (for example, shop rate for 2007: \$80.00/hour and \$105.00/hour for overtime and callout).

# 14.0 WARRANTY

- 14.1 Complete details of warranties shall be made available within twentyfour (24) hours of the request of the Contract Administrator.
- 14.2 The Contractor shall warrant **all equipment** and all parts thereof, against any defects of workmanship, construction and materials, and agrees to repair or replace, <u>without cost to the City</u>, any article that has become defective and not proven to have been caused by negligence on the part of the user within **two (2) years** from the date the equipment is put into service by the City of Winnipeg.
- 14.3 Notwithstanding 14.2 above, the Contractor shall warrant **all major components** including, but not limited to, engine, transmission, final drives, all wheel drive system (and all components thereof), pumps and motors, axle assemblies, tandem drives, etc. against any defects of workmanship, construction and materials, and agrees to repair or replace <u>without cost to the City</u>, articles that have become defective and not proven to have been caused by negligence on the part of the user within **Two (2) years** from the date the equipment is put into service by the City of Winnipeg.
- 14.3.1 Notwithstanding 14.2 above, the Contractor shall warrant **all attachments**, and all parts thereof, against any defects of workmanship, construction and materials, and agrees to repair or replace, <u>without cost to the City</u>, any article that has become defective and not proven to have been caused by negligence on the part of the user within **one (1) year** from the date the equipment is put into service by the City of Winnipeg.
- 14.4 <u>The warranty shall not include</u> regular maintenance items or any item deemed as a consumable that is subject to everyday wear and tear, during the regular operation of the unit.
- 14.4.1 If the equipment provided by the Contractor contains any part manufactured by an outside source, that falls under the description in Clause 14.4 above, and has a standard manufacture's warranty, the term's contained in the manufacture's warranty shall apply.
- 14.5 <u>The following shall be covered under manufacture's warranty</u> for six (6) months against defects:

### 15.0 DELIVERY

- 15.1 The equipment shall be serviced, ready for operation and delivered F.O.B. with the freight prepaid to the City of Winnipeg, Winnipeg Fleet Management Agency, 185 Tecumseh Street Winnipeg, Manitoba within <u>three (3) calendar weeks</u> from the date of official notification of award of Contract. The Contractor shall contact the Contract Administrator prior to delivery of the equipment.
- 15.2 The Contractor shall fax all vehicle serial numbers, hours/mileage to the Contract Administrator one (1) calendar week prior to delivery.
- 15.3 A pre-delivery inspection shall be performed by the Contractor on all equipment.
