1.0 INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETION OF SPECIFICATIONS

- 1.1 **The Fire Extinguishers** shall be furnished complete and ready for use by the Contractor. All parts not specifically mentioned but which are required to complete and place the **Fire Extinguishers** into successful operation shall be furnished as though specifically mentioned in these specifications.
- 1.2 It will be the responsibility of the Bidder to inform the City of any errors or omissions in these specifications, for under this Contract the Contractor shall be held responsible for the satisfactory operational function of the **Fire Extinguishers**.
- 1.3 All items in these specifications must be answered indicating compliance or non-compliance. Bidders shall state "yes" for compliance or state deviation, or give a reply where requested to do so. Deviations shall be clearly stated and fully detailed. Alternatives will be considered subject to evaluation.
- 1.4 Each bidder is required to fill in every blank. Failure to do so may be used as a basis for rejection of bid.
- 1.5 All applicable SAE standards form an integral part of these specifications and shall have precedence in any conflict concerning minimum acceptable standards.
- 1.6 The **Fire Extinguishers** must be tested and maintained as per the below standards.
 - <u>Underwriters' Laboratories of Canada (ULC)</u> and <u>must have the ULC label</u> on the extinguisher.
 - The **Fire Extinguisher** and all its components shall comply with all **Canadian Standards Association (C.S.A.).**
 - Must be inspected and tested in accordance with the <u>Standard of the National Fire Protection</u> <u>Association titled Portable Fire Extinguishers.</u>

2.0 SERVICE FACILITY

- 2.1 For the purpose of warranty repairs, the supplier shall have an authorized service facility located within 10 kilometres of the boundaries of the City of Winnipeg. The facility, or a portion thereof, shall be dedicated to the service and maintenance of the type **Fire Extinguishers** being offered. Further to B9.1, Bidders shall provide a description of the service facility including, but not limited to, number of qualified service staff, years of service experience, and general service capabilities within three (3) Business Days upon request of the Contract Administrator.
- 3.0 <u>SPECIFICATIONS</u>- ELIGIBLE MAKE BADGER FIRE PROCTECTION OR EQUIVALENT IN ACCORDANCE TO B5. SUBSTITUES STATED HEREIN.
- 3.1 <u>TYPE</u>- There are three basic classes of fire extinguishers. Fire extinguishers must be labelled to show the class of fire they can extinguish.

- The term "repeated failures" as determined by the Contract Administrator, and used herein is defined to mean, that when the same component, subassembly, or assembly develops repeated defects, breakdowns and/or malfunctions rendering the apparatus inoperative, or requiring repeated shop correction, service and/or replacement during the warranty period applicable for said component, subassembly, or assembly. Minor items or ordinary service adjustments are not included, or considered under the scope of "repeated failures", as well as other factors, such as operational damage due to accidents, misuse or lack of proper maintenance, service attention by not following the manufacturer's preventative maintenance schedule.
 4.5 Where a fire extinguisher develops "repeated failures" in service, the Contractor shall make any necessary engineering changes, repairs, alterations or
- Where a fire extinguisher develops "repeated failures" in service, the Contractor shall make any necessary engineering changes, repairs, alterations or modifications in order to guarantee reliability of performance, at no cost to the City, including all incidental costs, with a reapplied, full warranty as described in clause 4.4.

5.0 DELIVERY-

5.1 The equipment shall be serviced, ready for operation and delivered F.O.B. freight prepaid to the City of Winnipeg, Fleet Management Agency, 185 Tecumseh Street, Winnipeg, Manitoba within three (3) calendar weeks from the date of official notification of award of Contract. The Contractor shall contact the Contract Administrator prior to delivery of the equipment. The deployment plan calls for a six month installation schedule with February 2008 being the date for having all required extinguishers installed as required in each vehicle. The initial delivery of the items should represent 20% of total stated number with the rest delivered on an "as requested" basis from September 2007 to February 2008.
