#### (Manhole Trench Cages)

#### 1.0 INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETION OF SPECIFICATIONS

- 1.1 The Supply & Delivery of the Manhole Trench Cages shall be 2008 or 2009 model year. <u>Manitoba Health & Safety Work Place requires that all Manhole Trench Cages sold in</u> <u>Manitoba shall be certified and stamped by a registered Manitoba Certified Engineer</u>. Upon request of the contract administrator, the City may request published literature of the equipment bid and must be provided within forty-eight (48) hours. The equipment shall be furnished complete and ready for use by the Contractor. All parts not specifically mentioned but which are required to complete and place the equipment into successful operation shall be furnished as though specifically mentioned in these specifications.
- 1.2 It will be the responsibility of the Bidder to inform the City of any errors or omissions in these specifications, for under this Contract the Contractor shall be held responsible for the satisfactory operational function of the equipment.
- 1.3 All items in these specifications must be answered indicating compliance or non-compliance. <u>Bidders shall state "yes" for compliance or state deviation</u>, or give a reply where requested to do so. Deviations shall be clearly stated and fully detailed. Alternatives will be considered subject to evaluation.
- 1.4 Each bidder is required to fill in every blank. Failure to do so may be used as a basis for rejection of bid.
- 1.5 All applicable SAE standards form an integral part of these specifications and shall have precedence in any conflict concerning minimum acceptable standards.
- 1.6 <u>The completed equipment and all its components shall comply with all City of Winnipeg.</u> <u>Provincial and Federal Safety Standards & Regulations for the equipment being bid.</u>

#### 2.0 SERVICE FACILITY-

- 2.1 For the purpose of warranty repairs, the supplier shall have an authorized service facility. The facility, or a portion thereof, shall be dedicated to the service and maintenance of the type equipment being offered. Further to B9.1, Bidders shall provide a description of the service facility including, but not limited to, number of qualified service staff, years of service experience, and general service capabilities within three (3) Business Days upon request of the Contract Administrator.

Each session shall be approximately ½ day in duration and shall provide adequate familiarization and orientation on the equipment, to the satisfaction of the Contract Administrator. The training shall be conducted in Winnipeg at a location to be designated by the Contract Administrator.
- 5.2 State if other training aids (videos, CDs) are available.

#### 6.0 WARRANTY-

6.1 The warranty for the <u>Manhole Trench cages and all associated</u> <u>components</u> shall cover the complete equipment, and all parts thereof against any defects of workmanship, construction and materials, for a period of not less than <u>one (1) year unlimited hours</u>. Any article that has become defective\_during said warranty period and has not proven to have been caused by negligence on the part of the user shall be repaired or replaced at no cost to the City. The warranty shall be effective from the date the equipment is put into service by the City of Winnipeg.
