### PART E - SPECIFICATIONS

Revise: E2.5 to read: Basis of Payment

- (a) Mobilization and demobilization will be paid for at the Contract Lump Sum Price for "Mobilization and Demobilization," which price will be payment in full for performing all operations herein described and all other items incidental to the Work included in this Specification
- (b) Mobilization and demobilization will be paid for at a percentage of the Contract Lump Sum Price, measured as specified herein. These percentages shall be as follows:
  - when Contract Administrator is satisfied that construction has commenced 30%
  - ii) during construction 60%
  - iii) upon completion of the project 10%

Add: E4.5.6 Demolition, Base Course and Site Restoration

No separate measurement or payment will be made for demolition, base course and site restoration. These items of work are incidental to the Contract.
