### **PART D – SUPPLEMENTAL CONDITIONS**

Revise: D10 to read: **PERFORMANCE SECURITY**

Revise:D10.1 to read: If the Contract Price exceeds one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00), the Contractor shall provide and maintain performance security until the expiration of the warranty period in the form of:

- (a) a performance bond of a company registered to conduct the business of a surety in Manitoba, in the form attached to these Supplemental Conditions (Form H1: Performance Bond), in the amount of fifty percent (50%) of the Contract Price; or
- (b) an irrevocable standby letter of credit issued by a bank or other financial institution registered to conduct business in Manitoba and drawn on a branch located in Winnipeg, in the form attached to these Supplemental Conditions (Form H2: Irrevocable Standby Letter of Credit), in the amount of fifty percent (50%) of the Contract Price; or
- (c) a certified cheque or draft payable to “The City of Winnipeg”, drawn on a bank or other financial institution registered to conduct business in Manitoba, in the amount of fifty percent (50%) of the Contract Price.

Revise D10.1.1 to read: Where the performance security is in the form of a certified cheque or draft, it will be deposited by the City. The City will not pay any interest on certified cheques or drafts furnished as performance security

Revise D10.2 to read: The Contractor shall provide the City Solicitor with the required performance security within seven (7) Calendar Days of notification of the award of the Contract by way of Purchase Order and prior to the commencement of any Work on the Site

## **PART E – SPECIFICATIONS**

Revise: E5.1(a) to read: In accordance with the Manual of Temporary Traffic Control, the Contractor ("Agency" in the manual) shall place all necessary temporary regulatory signs. The Contractor shall bear all costs associated with the placement of temporary regulatory signs.

Revise: E6.1(d) to read: Complete lane closures, for the purposes of removing the existing aluminum overhead sign structures for transportation, for northbound Dunkirk Drive and southbound Lagimodiere Boulevard will only be permitted on a Sunday between the hours of 09:00 am to 3:30 pm. Complete lane closures shall be limited to a maximum of 15 minutes. If the contractor determines that they are unable to limit the lane closures to the above timeframes, they may apply in writing to the Contract Administrator to determine an alternate schedule.
