



GENERAL NOTES

- REFER TO TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS FOR EQUIPMENT AND MATERIAL SPECIFICATIONS AND INSTALLATION CONSTRUCTION
- AND PHASING REQUIREMENTS. INSULATE DUCTWORK WHERE INDICATED AND SPECIFIED.
- SUPPORT ALL DUCTWORK TO MEET CODE REQUIREMENTS & ESTABLISHED INDUSTRY TRADE PRACTICES, (SMACNA, ASHRAE).
- INVESTIGATE SITE PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION TO CONFIRM ALL DIMENSIONS AND INSTALLATION REQ'S.
