1.0 MAINTENANCE MANUAL

- 1.1 On completion of project submit to Consultant three (3)copies of Operations Data and Maintenance Manuals as follows:
 - 1.1.1 Bind data in vinyl hard covered, three ring loose leaf binder for 8 1/2" x 11" paper.
 - 1.1.2 Enclose title sheet, labelled "Operation Data and Maintenance Manual", project name, date and list of contents.
 - 1.1.3 Organize contents into applicable sections of work to parallel project specification break-down. Mark each section by labelled tabs protected with celluloid covers fastened to hard paper dividing sheets.
- 1.2 Include following information plus data specified.
 - 1.2.1 Maintenance instruction for finished surface and materials.
 - 1.2.2 Copy of hardware and paint schedules.
 - 1.2.3 Description, operation, and maintenance instructions for equipment and system, including complete list of equipment and parts list. Indicate name plate information such as make, size capacity, serial number.
 - 1.2.4 Names, addresses and phone numbers of Subcontractors and suppliers.
 - 1.2.5 Guarantees, warranties and bonds showing:
 - 1.2.5.1 Name and address of Project
 - 1.2.5.2 Guarantee commencement date (date of Certificate of Substantial Completion)
 - 1.2.5.3 Duration of warranty.
 - 1.2.5.4 Clear indication of what is being guaranteed and what remedial action will be taken under guarantee.
 - 1.2.5.5 Signature and seal of Contractor.
 - 1.2.5.6 Additional material used in project listed under various sections showing name of manufacturer and source of supply.

- 1.2.5.7 Neatly type lists and notes. Use clear drawings, diagrams or manufacturer's literature.
- 1.2.5.8 Include one complete set of final approved Shop Drawings (bound separately) indicating corrections and changes made during fabrication and installation.

2.0 MAINTENANCE MATERIAL

- 2.1 Where supply of maintenance material is specified, deliver to Consultant as follows:
 - 2.1.1 Materials in unbroken cartons, or if not supplied in cartons, they shall be strongly packaged.
 - 2.1.2 Clearly mark as to content.
 - 2.1.3 If applicable give colour, room number of area where material used.

3.0 AS-BUILT DRAWINGS

- 3.1 The General Contractor shall provide the Owner "As-Built Drawings" (Record Drawings) and digital record drawings (CD on Autocad Version 2000 of the "As-Built" Drawings) for the owner's use.
- 3.2 The Consultant Design Team will prepare the digital "As-Built Drawings indicating the design revisions to the tender documents "at cost "(ie. Addenda and Change Orders. The General Contractor shall pay the Consultant for this service.
